Wyandott Nation Sept. 16th 1828

Dear Father Finley

I have considered it my duty to keep you informed of the progress of matters pertaining to the church here. On yesterday the official members formally declined having any thing more to do with the Church South. The following is a copy of the proceedings on yesterday.

" Minutes of the 4th quarterly conference for Wyandott mission held at the camp ground in Wyandott Nation on the 15th day of Sept. 1828 Members present

proceeded to the examination of character.
Bro. Squire Grey Eyes being first called, stated

"that he was unwilling to remain in
the employment of the Church South
his character was passed. Mrs Clark and
Bigtree character passed but declined a
renewal of license. John Hicks our char.
passed license not renewed Little chief
character passed license not renewed
J.M. Armstrong character passed declined
renewal of license. 3^d Is there any other
business? none." (Signed)
