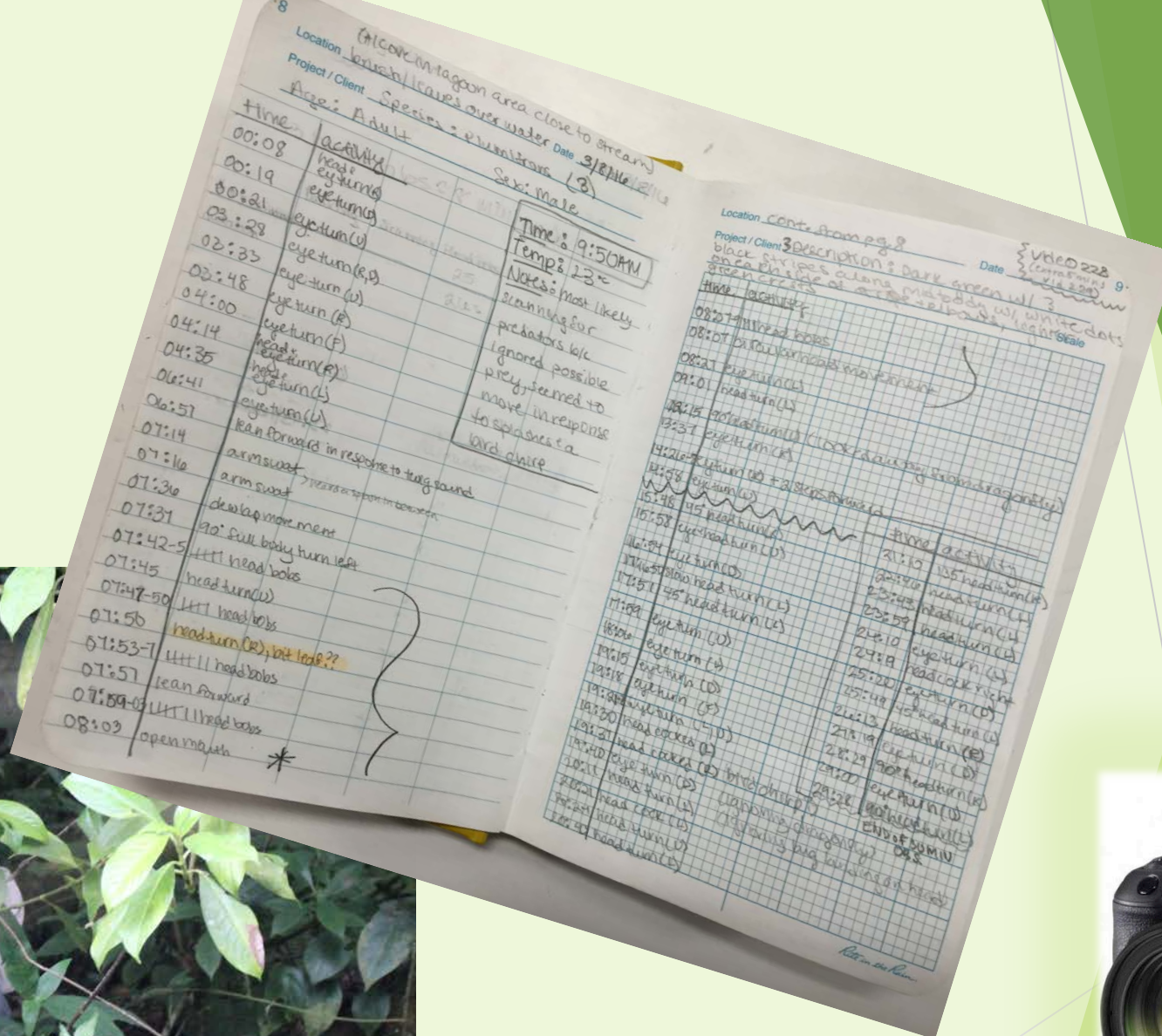
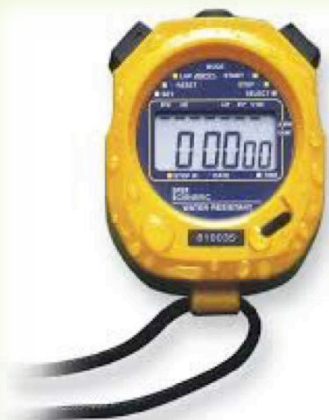










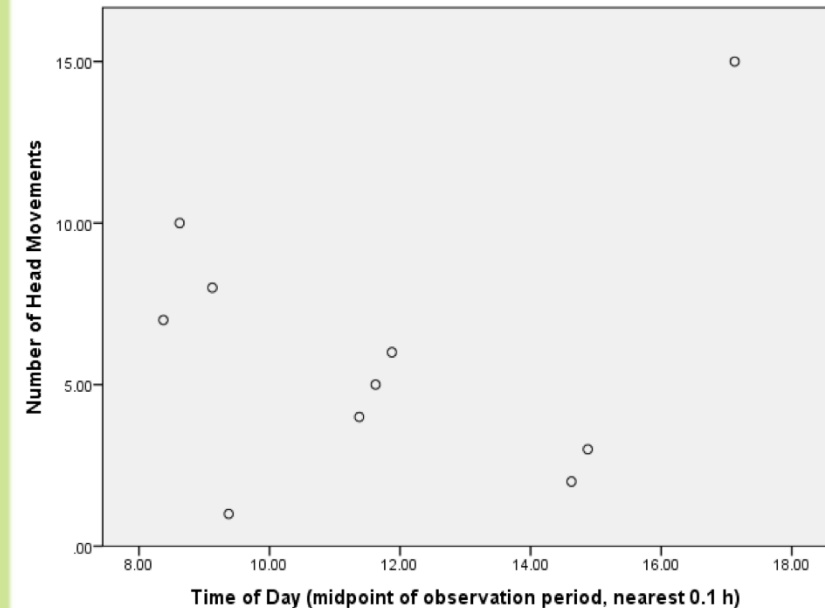

Figure 5. Scanning and Foraging Activity Level Across Species

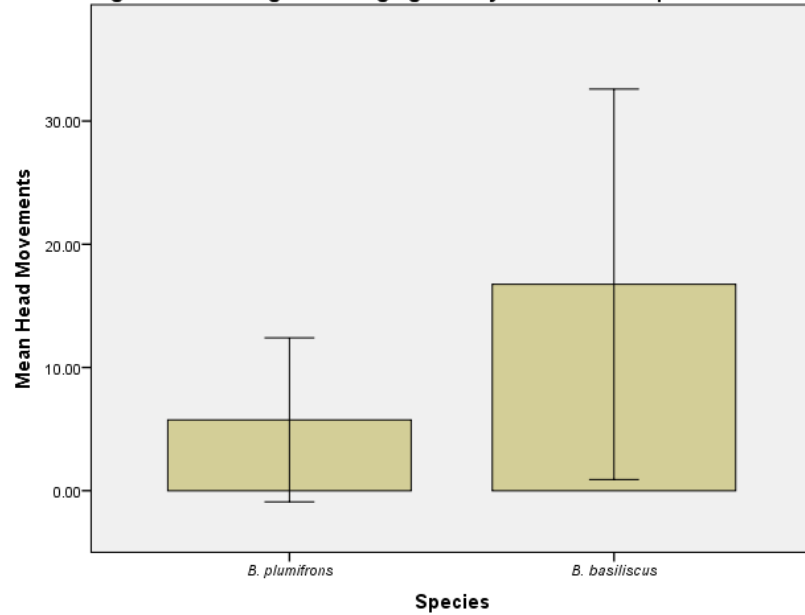


Figure 1. Scanning and Foraging Activity Level Across Habitats of Common Basilisk

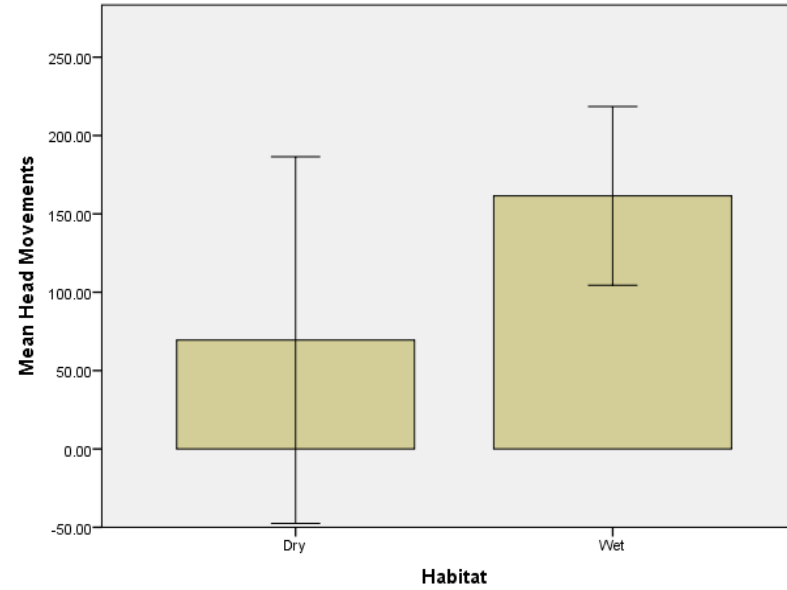


Figure 4. Scanning and Foraging Activity Level Across Time of Day for Common Basilisk

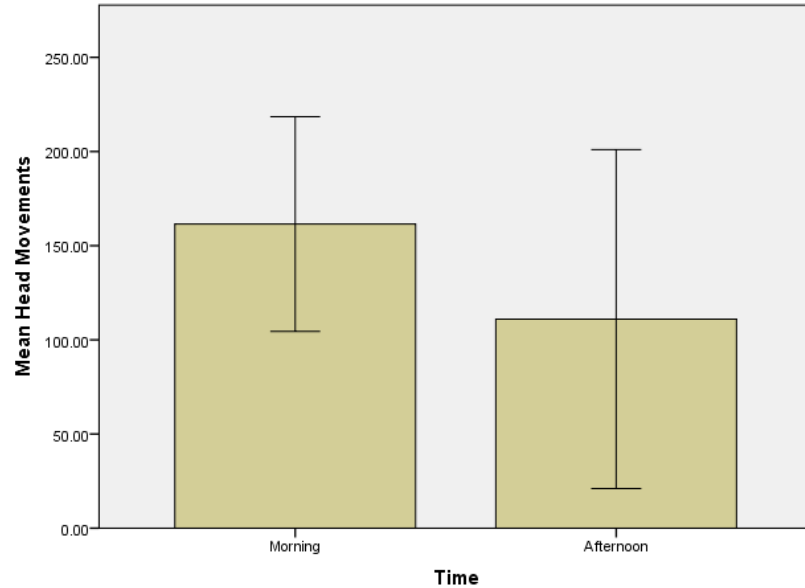
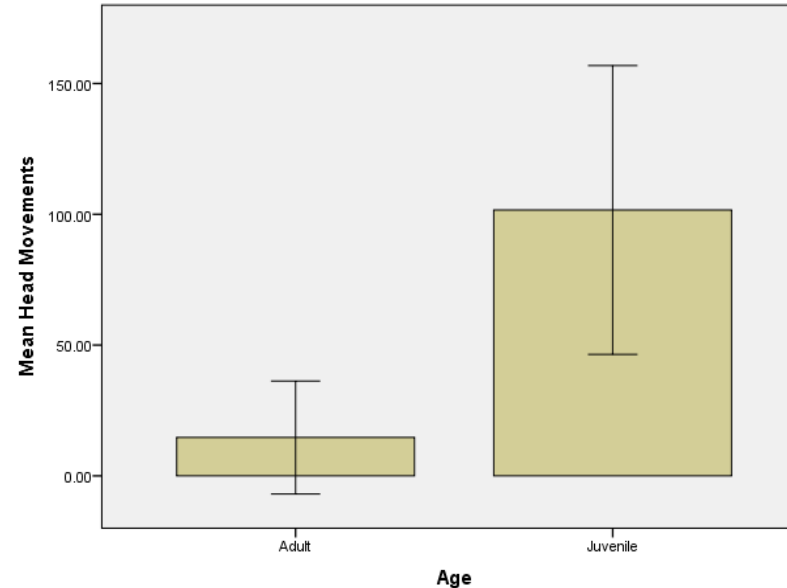


Figure 2. Scanning and Foraging Activity Level Across Age Groups for Common Basilisk
